

## **Loop Organics Incident Notification**

What is a Pollution Incident? A pollution incident means an incident or set of circumstances during or as a consequence of which there is or is likely to be a leak, spill or other escape or deposit of a substance, as a result of which pollution has occurred, is occurring or is likely to occur. It includes an incident or set of circumstances in which a substance has been placed or disposed of on premises, but it does not include an incident or set of circumstances involving only the emission of any noise.

#### **Notification Process**



Call Emergency Services first if required.

Contact Loop Organics **Environment Manager and AGL Emergency Coordinator**( see contact details below)



If NO follow Loop Organics incident management process.

If YES Environment Manager to immediately notify relevant authorities (see contact details below).

Implement Pollution Incident Response Management Plan.
Implement Community Notification Protocol if required.

Review PIRMP within 1 month of incident and update as required.

# **Community Notification**

#### **Is Community Notification Required?**

In the event of an incident occurring which affects offsite receptors Loop Organics may be required to contact their commercial, industrial and residential neighbours to inform them of the circumstances of the incident and what action is being taken in response to it. Notification will depend on the type and severity incident (refer to Loop Organics PIRMP).
